Our Mandate Matters Sunday October 25, 2009 Pastor Warner Smith

Message Truth:

Does church matter to you? If so, how much does it matter? A lot or a little? Many today believe that spirituality matters or even that Jesus matters, but too few actually think that church matters at all. Sadly, with increasing frequency many believe church often does not matter - that is until they need one. The fact is the church does matter, and it matters a lot. Why? The church matters to Christ; He founded it and calls it His bride. No other organization on the planet has the mandate of the church. The church is the only institution tasked with bringing the light of Christ into this dark world. By God's design the truth about His son Jesus Christ is to be found through His church.

Message Text:

⁸ Though I am the least deserving of all God's people, he graciously gave me the privilege of telling the Gentiles about the endless treasures available to them in Christ. ⁹ I was chosen to explain to everyone this mysterious plan that God, the Creator of all things, had kept secret from the beginning. ¹⁰ God's purpose in all this was to use the church to display his wisdom in its rich variety to all the unseen rulers and authorities in the heavenly places. ¹¹ This was his eternal plan, which he carried out through Christ Jesus our Lord.

The Church is Unique Among Human Organizations Only the church:

- endeavors to execute God's plan
- is commissioned to be good news and tell good news

- is interested in saving the soul and reconciling man to God
- seeks good for all of society
- is founded by Jesus Christ

" 38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized. every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit. 39 The promise is for you and your children and for all who are far off—for all whom the Lord our God will call." ⁴⁰ With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, "Save yourselves from this corrupt generation." ⁴¹ Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day. ⁴²They **devoted themselves** to **the apostles' teaching** and to the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer. Everyone was filled with awe, and many wonders and miraculous signs were done by the apostles. 44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. ⁴⁵ Selling their possessions and goods, **they gave to anyone** as he had need. 46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts,

⁴⁷ praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.
