Message Truth:

Does church matter to you? If so, how much does it matter? A lot or a little? The fact is the church does matter, and it matters a lot. Why? Unfortunately, too few Christians are committed to being obedient in their lifestyles and maintaining unity in their relationships by being accountable to God and one another. Typically our church experience is marked by division and disappointment. Many today shop around without committing to a local body of believers or join but then drop out. This is not how Christ's bride is to behave. For church to matter to us as much as it should we must honor the commitments we have made to obey Christ, live for Him personally, and walk in unity and accountability with our fellow brothers and sisters in Christ.
