Message Truth:

Were you to honestly evaluate your life would you say that you are making a mess or leaving your mark? What differentiates a Christian from a non-Christian? What are the marks which define authentic Christianity? A Christian is simply one who has asked God for forgiveness and been forgiven. Many people claim to be Christians; but not all who claim the name are truly His. We are identifying ten distinguishing marks of authentic Christian faith. We have discussed the first three marks of a genuine work of grace: a Christian loves completely, a Christian will obey consistently, and a Christian lives authentically. This week we will see that a Christian confesses continually and knows competently. What indelible marks of your Christianity are visible to those who know you?

Indelible adjective 1. (of ink or a mark) unable to be removed. 2. Unable to be forgotten.
