Six Temptations Men Face

Message Truth:

Too many American families are in crisis - particularly in the church. Too often the problem in Christian homes is the failure of Christian men. Dad, children who are raised in genuine Christian homes will increasingly experience an advantage in society and in their personal relationships over their counterparts who are reared in dysfunctional families. Godly families also bear witness to the reality of God's truth in a society that increasingly is seeking genuine Christian examples. Today we will explain six common temptations which men face and must learn to resist in order to build families that pass the test of time.
