Jesus Prayed for Us to Be Kept Safe from the Evil One

Message Truth:

In His Model Prayer, Jesus taught us to pray for protection from the evil one. In His High Priestly Prayer, Jesus prayed for us to be protected from the evil one for the purpose of our maintaining unity after the pattern of the Father and the Son. In this High Priestly Prayer Jesus also prayed for spiritual outcomes, as well as for future reality. Today we will examine the spiritual protection and unity aspects of His prayer and use them as a model for our spiritual warfare praying. Each of us are constantly under attack from the evil one. It is time that we realize and acknowledge this and come together and battle these forces of hell. Jesus' blood was shed for everyone, the testimony of Scripture is true, so for what are we waiting?! I yearn for our church family to be prepared to take on and defeat the enemy. This is the necessary first step for us to make an eternal and temporal impact in our community.

Message Text:

⁶ I have revealed you to **those whom you gave me out of the world**. They were yours; you gave them to me and they have obeyed your word. ⁷ Now they know that everything you have given me comes from you. ⁸ For I gave them the words you gave me and they accepted them. They knew with certainty that I came from you, and they believed that you sent me. ⁹ I pray for them. I am not praying for the world, but for those you have given me, for they are yours. ¹⁰ All I have is yours, and all you have is mine. And glory has come to me through them. ¹¹ I will remain in the world no longer, but they are still in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name -the name you gave me -- so that they may be one as we are one. ¹² While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. None has been lost except the one doomed to destruction so that Scripture would be fulfilled.¹³ "I am coming to you now, but I say these things while I am still in the world, so that they may have the full measure of my joy within them. ¹⁴ I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. ¹⁵ My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. ¹⁶ They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. ¹⁷ Sanctify (set apart for sacred use or make holy) them by the truth; your word is truth. ¹⁸ As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. ¹⁹ For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified.²⁰ My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message,²¹ that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they also be in us so that the world may believe that you have sent me.²² I have given them the alory that you gave me, that they may be one as we are one: ²³ I in them and you in me. May they be brought to complete unity to let the world know that you sent me and have loved them even as you have loved me.²⁴ Father, I want those you have given me to be with me where I am, and to see my glory, the glory you have given me because you loved me before the creation of the world. John 17:6-24
