# Prayer As a Weapon of Spiritual Warfare

### Message Truth:

We have learned that Satan attacks Christians with two primary weapons: temptation and accusation. Christians, however, are not left defenseless against these attacks. Our primary defense is our spiritual armor and prayer. We have learned that while we do have an enemy, it is not one another. Satan is our enemy. Our unity is critically important in our ability to engage in spiritual warfare. Jesus has prayed for our unity and has given us a new command to love one another. Last week we learned that our love for one another is the authenticating mark of the gospel. Today we will discover how prevailing and persistent prayer is one of the greatest weapons we have been given to wage war against our enemy.

<sup>3</sup> For though we live in the world, we do not wage war as the world does. <sup>4</sup> The weapons we fight with are not the weapons of the world. On the contrary, they have divine power to demolish strongholds. 2 Corinthians 10:3–4

## In response to the world, Scripture instructs Christians to:

#### • Not love the world

<sup>15</sup> Do not love the world nor the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

1 John 2:15 (NASB)

## • Not let it shape our values

<sup>2</sup> And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, so that you may prove what the will of God is, that which is good and acceptable and perfect.

Romans 12:2 (NASB)

• Live through Jesus as the crucified to the world

<sup>14</sup> But may it never be that I would boast, except in the cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, through which the world has been crucified to me, and I to the world.

Galatians 6:14 (NASB)

- We need to be cognizant of the reality of Satan and his fallen demonic assistants. Understand that spiritual warfare is real and necessary.
- We need to realize that God still expects His followers to be obedient to and occupied with completing the Great Commission.
- We need to oppose Satan's schemes by seriously engaging in intercessory prayer for lost people to be saved and for world evangelization to be completed.
- We need to emphasize unity in the church as we work to fulfill God's call for us.
- We need to support evangelism and all of our mission work with prayer.

## In prayer we should ask questions such as:

What is wrong with my practice of Christianity?

What is wrong with our church?

What is wrong with our city?

From where do these problem come?

What can I do to make things better?
