We Have an Enemy and It's Not Each Other

Message Truth:

Step one in our warfare plan is to realize that we do have an enemy and that it is not one another. Jesus has and continues to pray for our spiritual protection and unity. Our unity is critically important to our ability to engage in spiritual warfare. In His Model Prayer, Jesus taught us to pray for protection from the evil one. In His High Priestly Prayer, Jesus also prayed for protection from the evil one as well as for our spiritual unity. Each of us need to understand our great need for protection, what it means to pray for protection from evil, and how we accomplish this protection.

Message Text:

11 Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name --the name you gave me—so that they may be one as we
are one. 12 While I was with them, I protected them and
kept them safe by that name you gave me. . . . 15 My
prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that
you protect them from the evil one . . . 20 My prayer is not
for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in
me through their message, 21 that all of them may be one,
Father, just as you are in me and I am in you. May they
also be in us so that the world may believe that you have
sent me.
