We Have an Enemy and It's Not Each Other

Message Truth:

Step one in our warfare plan is to realize that we do have an enemy and that it is not one another. Jesus has and continues to pray for our spiritual protection and unity. Our unity is critically important to our ability to engage in spiritual warfare. In His Model Prayer, Jesus taught us to pray for protection from the evil one. In His High Priestly Prayer, Jesus also prayed for protection from the evil one as well as for our spiritual unity. Each of us need to understand our great need for protection, what it means to pray for protection from evil, and how we accomplish this protection.

⁷ And when you pray, do not keep on babbling like pagans, for they think they will be heard because of their many words. ⁸ Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him. ⁹ This, then, is how you should pray: 'Our Father in heaven, hallowed be your name, ¹⁰ your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. ¹¹ Give us today our daily bread.

¹² Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. ¹³ **And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one.** ¹⁴ For if you forgive men when they sin against you, your heavenly Father will also forgive you.

¹⁵ But if you do not forgive men their sins, your Father will not forgive your sins. Matthew 6:7-15

¹¹ Holy Father, protect them by the power of your name -- the name you gave me—so that they may be one as we are one. ¹² While I was with them, I protected them and kept them safe by that name you gave me. . . . ¹⁵ My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but **that you protect them from the evil one** . . . ²⁰ My prayer is not for them alone. **I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message,** ²¹ that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you.
