# We Have an Enemy and It's Not Each Other

### Message Truth:

Step one in our warfare plan is to realize that we do have an enemy and that it is not one another. Jesus has and continues to pray for our spiritual protection and unity. Our unity is critically important to our ability to engage in spiritual warfare. In His Model Prayer, Jesus taught us to pray for protection from the evil one. In His High Priestly Prayer, Jesus also prayed for protection from the evil one as well as our spiritual unity. Each of us needs to understand our great need for protection, what it means to pray for protection from evil, and how we accomplish this protection. Today we will seek to understand the methods which Satan uses against us as he engages us (whether we are aware of it or not) in spiritual warfare.

Satan is in no way equal to God. God is all powerful (omnipotent), Satan is not. God is all-knowing (omniscient), Satan is not. God is everywhere at the same time (omnipresent), Satan cannot be. God is truth; Satan is the father of lies. God is without beginning or end. Satan is a created being whose end waits the providential time of God.

<sup>44</sup> You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desire. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies.

Methods of Satan's A
● For the U
1. By providing lies to which they may cling.
2. By making sin attractive and alluring.
3. By snatching away the Word before it takes root.
4. By promoting distorted views of the gospel.
<sup>4</sup> for the weapons of our warfare are not of the flesh, but divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses.  2 Corinthians 10:4 (NASB)
5. By raising up false teachers.
<sup>13</sup> For such men are false apostles, deceitful workers, disguising themselves as apostles of Christ.  2 Corinthians 11:13 (NASB)

#### As Accuser of the Saints
