Message Truth:

Elohim is the common word in Hebrew used to refer to God. Elohim is used to refer to the true God, Yahweh, but is also used to refer to other gods as well. It is like the word "god" in English - it may refer to the true God or to any object of worship. It is thought that this word was used by the Hebrews to show their neighbors that Elohim was the transcendent, sovereign and universal Lord, as compared to all the other gods. Elohim is plural in form. While the Jewish scholar would tell us this is a plural of majesty and has nothing to say about the Trinity, I must disagree. I believe that the plural use of Elohim shows us that God the Father, Son and Spirit are one God. Taken together, Yahweh Elohim, we can say our God exists and He reigns over all!
