# Open Before Christmas: Four Gifts That Show Jesus Your Love

#### Series Truth:

Society and the church have agreed that the giving of gifts is the socially acceptable way to celebrate the birth of Christ. But what gifts, and to whom should they be given, and is this what Jesus taught us? Could our current practice have more to do with our acceptance of hidden worldviews than with the clear and convincing teaching of the Gospel of Jesus Christ? I believe so! Therefore, over the next four weeks we will endeavor to discover what gifts those who claim His name should give Jesus every day and not just at Christmas.

<sup>6</sup> "With what shall I come before the LORD, and bow myself before God on high? Shall I come before him with burnt offerings, with calves a year old? <sup>7</sup> Will the LORD be pleased with thousands of rams, with ten thousands of rivers of oil? Shall I give my firstborn for my transgression, the fruit of my body for the sin of my soul?" <sup>8</sup> He has told you, O man, what is good; and what does the LORD require of you but **to do** justice, and **to love** kindness, and **to walk** humbly with your God? Micah 6:6–8 (ESV)

<sup>26</sup> "So **have no fear** of them, for nothing is covered that will not be revealed, or hidden that will not be known.<sup>27</sup> What I tell you in the dark, say in the light, and what you hear whispered, proclaim on the housetops.<sup>28</sup> And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather fear him who can destroy both soul and body in hell.<sup>29</sup> Are not two sparrows sold for a penny? And not one of them will fall to the ground apart from your Father.<sup>30</sup> But even the hairs of your head are all numbered.<sup>31</sup> Fear not, therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. <sup>32</sup> So everyone who acknowledges me before men, I also will acknowledge before my Father who is in heaven, <sup>33</sup> but whoever denies me before men, I also will deny before my Father who is in heaven.<sup>34</sup> "Do not think that I have come to bring peace to the earth. I have not come to bring peace, but a sword. <sup>35</sup> For I have come to set a man **against** his father, and a daughter against her mother, and a daughter-in-law against her mother-in-law.<sup>36</sup> And a person's enemies will be those of his own household.<sup>37</sup> Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me, and whoever loves son or daughter more than me is not **worthy** of me.<sup>38</sup> And whoever does not take his cross and follow me is not worthy of me. <sup>39</sup> Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it. Matthew 10:26-39 (ESV)
