#### Message Truth:

If God could make nature so beautiful in six days of creation, imagine how wonderful our heavenly home will be with Jesus making preparations now for over 2,000 years and counting. What will heaven be like? What will we be like in heaven? What will we do in heaven? Who will be in heaven with us? When do we go to heaven (immediately after death, or must we wait for the world to end)? Today we will concentrate on whose is heaven and begin to discuss how heaven will be different from life on earth.
