# I Am the Way, the Truth, and the Life

Easter Sunday, April 24, 2011 Pastor Warner Smith

#### Message Truth:

The sixth instance of the "I Am" saying used by John, to reassure his reader of Christ's divinity, is the assertion that Jesus is the Way, the Truth, and the Life. Jesus reveals that only He can lead us to God. He is going to His Father's house and prepare us a place, come back after us, and take us home with Him. He can do this because He, Himself, is the Way to God, the Truth about God, and the Living Representation of God. By seeing Jesus, His disciples have seen God; by knowing Jesus, His disciples have known God; because Jesus is God.

### Message Text:
